



Test Positive?

Treatment is Available for COVID-19.

There are two types of treatment – oral and IV – you can ask your doctor about.

What should I do if I test positive for COVID-19?

If you test positive and have symptoms, talk to your health care provider right away for help finding the treatment that is best for you.

Treatments work best when you receive them as soon as possible after becoming sick, so it is important to get tested and talk to your doctor right away.

Am I eligible?

People 12 years or older who test positive and are symptomatic can receive oral antiviral medicine within 5 days of having symptoms or treatment through IV infusion within 7 days of having symptoms.



Vaccination is still the best way to prevent COVID-19 infection.
